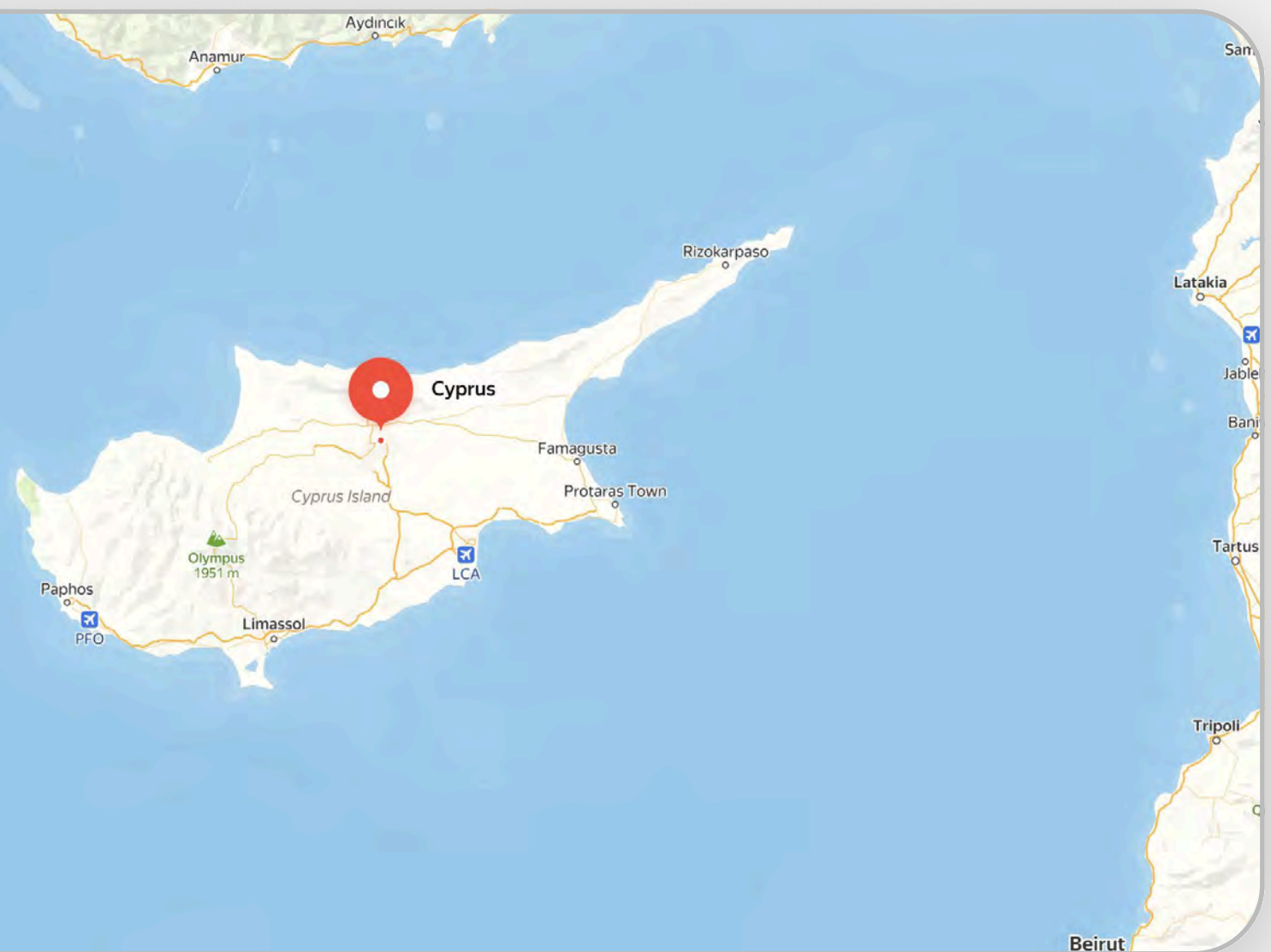

About Cyprus



The Republic of Cyprus is located at the crossroads of North Africa, Europe, and Asia Minor. The state occupies up to 57% of the island of the same name and nearby islands: Geronisos, Gluconitis, Kili, Kiedes, Cordilia, and Mazaki.

The island is divided into northern and southern parts. The north is controlled by the partially recognized Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. About 5% of the territory consists of British military bases and the UN buffer zone.

Nature & Culture

Cyprus enjoys a Mediterranean, subtropical climate with up to eight months of warm weather annually and mild winters where temperatures rarely drop below +10°C. Scenic lagoons, mountain ranges, cypress forests, and historical landmarks make it an ideal place to live and travel.

Cyprus has a population of approximately 1.2 million, of which 20% are foreign nationals. The Russian-speaking community numbers around 80,000, ensuring a comfortable environment for expatriates.

Environmental Commitment

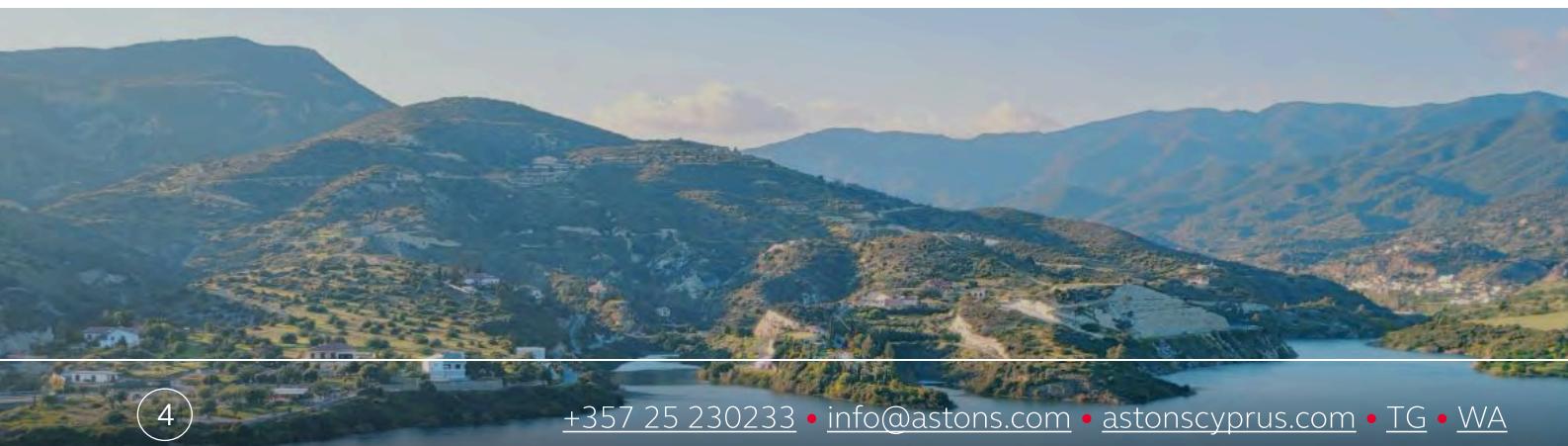

Terms and conditions of the Permanent Residence Programme in Cyprus

From €300,000

Purchase of new property from the developer at any stage of construction

This can be one or more properties if their combined value exceeds a certain threshold. A VAT of between 5% and 19% is also required depending on the property type, the property's area and additional conditions.

Basic requirements for an investor to obtain a residence permit:

- **The investment property must be a new dwelling from the developer.**
Acquisition of secondary property is not allowed.

- It is possible to obtain a CoML by buying **multiple properties**

- **Real estate can be purchased in the name of a company, not an individual.**
The company must be registered in the name of the applicant or his/her spouse, who are the sole shareholders.

Under the programme, it is not necessary to reside permanently in Cyprus — it is sufficient to visit at least once every two years. The residence permit is indefinite and applies to the family members of the principal applicant.

Residency status gives the opportunity to obtain citizenship of Cyprus, a country of the European Union, after 8 years if all the necessary conditions are met.

Additional Requirements for the Investor to Obtain Permanent Residency

No criminal record.

Employment in Cyprus **is not permitted**; however, business ownership and income from overseas sources are allowed.

A minimum **annual income** of **at least €50,000**. The income is increased by €15,000 for the spouse and €10,000 for each minor child of the applicant and/or their spouse.

Income sources include salaries, pensions, dividends, interest, rental income, etc. A spouse's income may also be considered when calculating total income.

A tax declaration from the **investor's country of tax residence** is required.

Individuals whose **assets are under EU sanctions** cannot participate in the investment programme.

Applicants must visit Cyprus **within a year of approval** to submit biometrics and collect their PR card.

Geography of Cyprus



Cyprus's capital is Nicosia, but other key cities include Limassol, Larnaca, Paphos. Well-known tourist destinations Ayia Napa and Protaras are located in the Famagusta region.

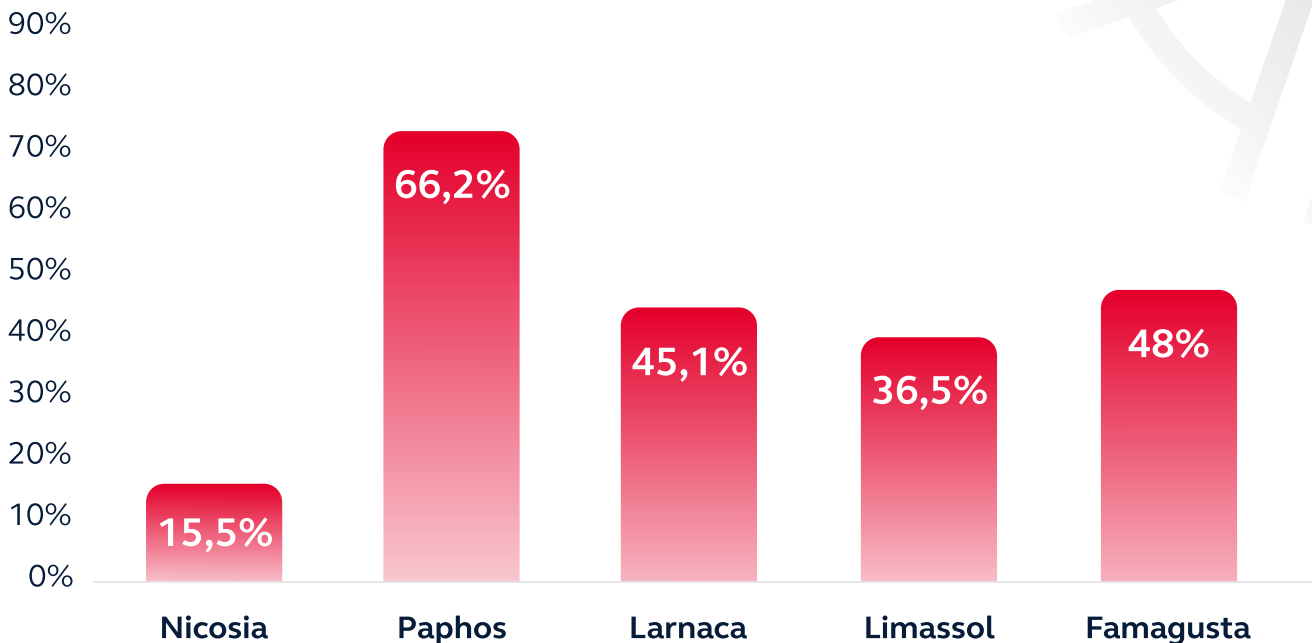
The island is divided into northern and southern regions. The partially recognised Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus controls the northern part. Approximately 5% of the territory consists of British Sovereign Base Areas and the UN Buffer Zone

The Republic of Cyprus has been a member of the European Union since 2004. According to President Nikos Christodoulides, the country is now at the final stage of preparations for accession to the Schengen Area. The authorities confirm that the core technical and administrative requirements have already been fulfilled. Cyprus will be able to join the Schengen Area once the experts of the European Commission complete their assessment.

Cyprus Real Estate Market

Foreign property transactions account for **40% of total annual sales** in Cyprus.

Property sales in **Paphos** are dominated by foreign buyers, who account for **66.2%** of total sales in the district. Paphos is followed by **Famagusta 48%**, **Larnaca 45.1%**, **Limassol 36.5%** and **Nicosia**, where foreign buyers accounted for **15.5%** of sales in the area.



What to Expect from the Real Estate Market in 2026?

- **Coastal regions will retain their leading position**

Limassol, Paphos and Larnaca will continue to attract both local and international buyers. Demand will remain focused on high-quality residential developments, seaside properties, and assets suitable for residence permits and long-term investment strategies.

- **Cyprus' accession to Schengen will strengthen international demand**

The expected accession of Cyprus to the Schengen Area may become an additional driver of demand, particularly among investors who view Cyprus as part of a broader European strategy for residence, business, and personal mobility.

- **The market will move into a phase of calmer, more sustainable growth**

Following the strong performance of 2024–2025, growth rates are likely to moderate. This should be seen as a positive development: less overheating, greater predictability, and clearer conditions for long-term investors.

- **The rental segment will remain one of the key demand drivers**

Rising tourism, together with the continued inflow of expatriates and international professionals, will sustain strong demand in the rental market. Apartments in urban centres and coastal locations are expected to be particularly sought after, supporting the appeal of income-generating investment properties.

Larnaca

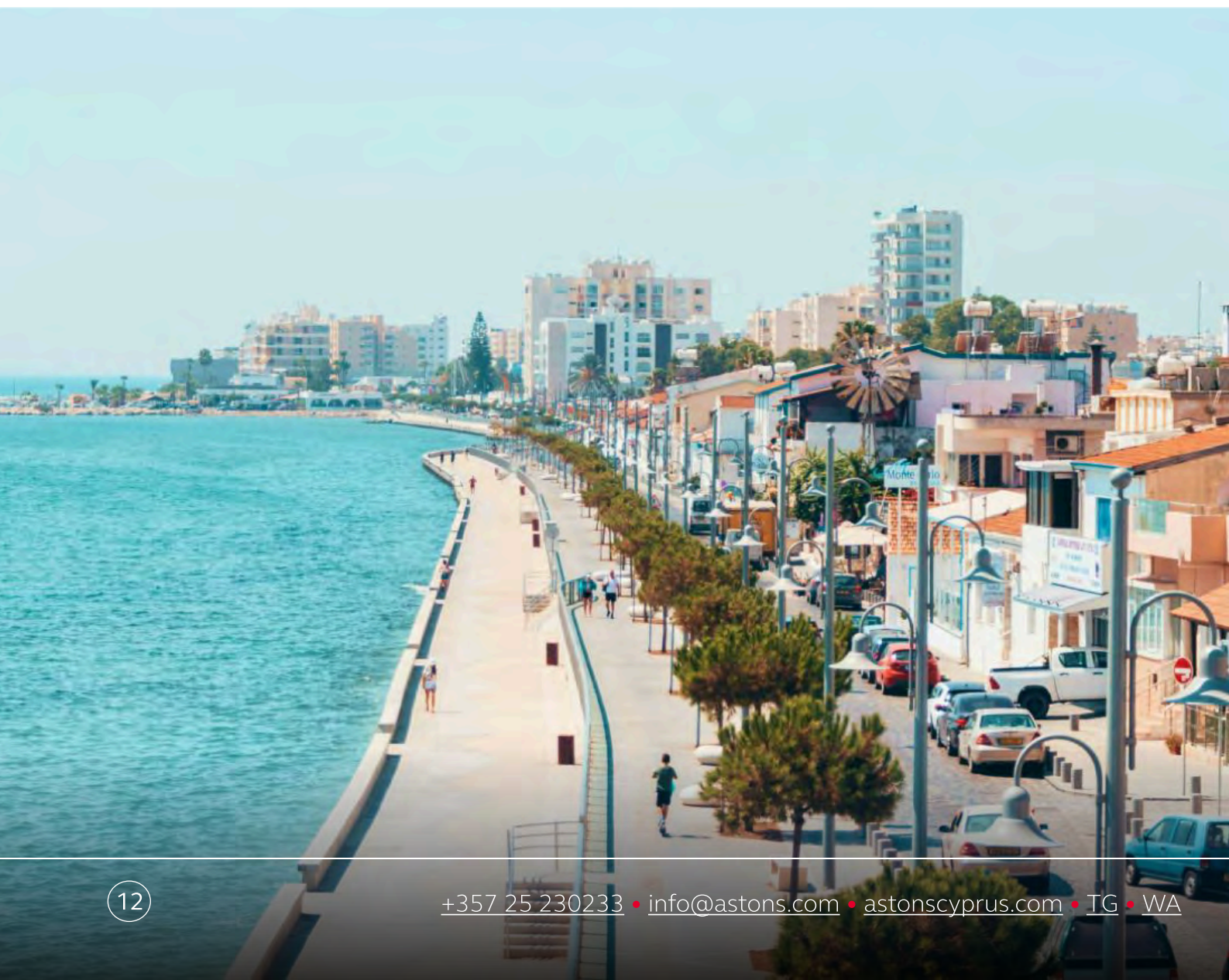

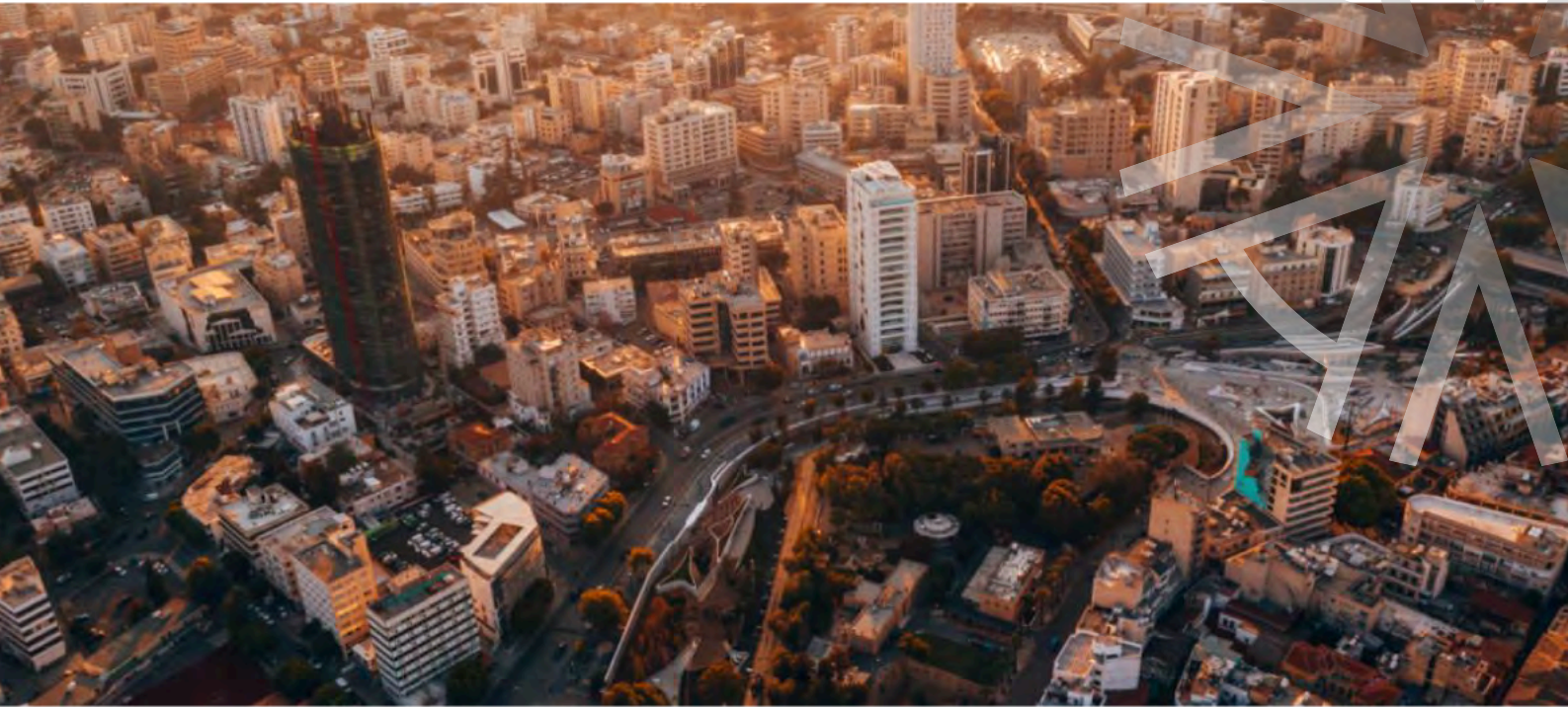

Cyprus Tax System

Cyprus offers one of the most attractive tax regimes in Europe. The corporate tax rate stands at 15%, placing it among the lowest in the European Union.

Individuals' tax obligations depend on their residency status. Tax residents of Cyprus are divided by status into **Domicile** and **Non-Domicile**. The first status is given to those born in Cyprus or who have lived there for more than 17 years. All other residents receive Non-Domicile status.

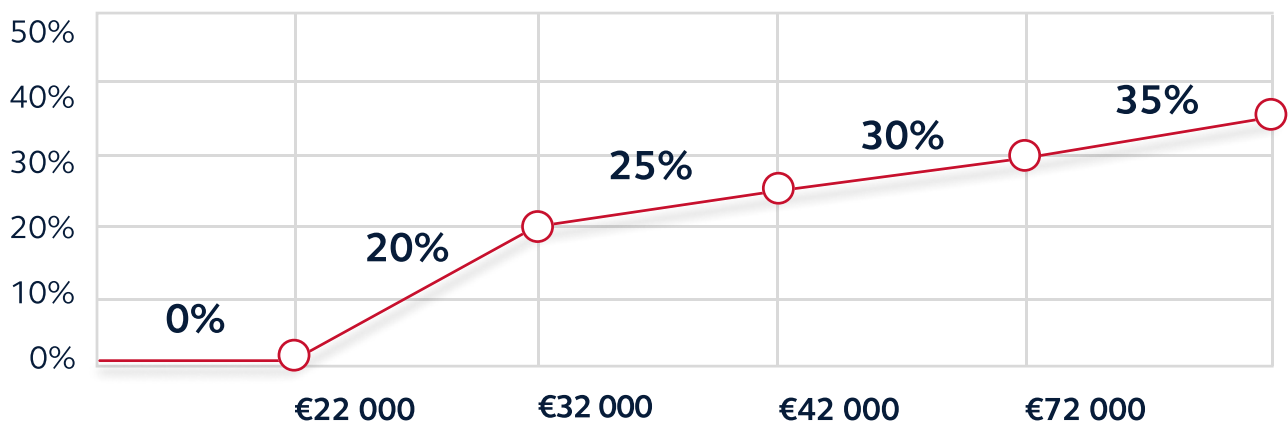
Non-Domicile residents are exempt from taxation on the following sources of income:

- Interest earnings
- Rental income from properties
- Dividends received from companies worldwide
- Capital gains (except gains from the sale of real estate located in Cyprus)
- No Special Defence Contribution (SDC) tax is required.

Becoming a tax resident of the country and then formalising Non-Domicile status can be done under the "183-day" or "60-day" rule.

- The 183-day rule applies if you spend more than 183 days in Cyprus within a calendar year.
- The 60-day rule applies if you reside in Cyprus for at least 60 days per year and do not stay in another country for more than 183 days in the same year, meaning you do not qualify as a tax resident elsewhere. For this rule, receiving income from a Cypriot company and having a permanent residence on the island is also essential.

Personal Income Tax Rates



Government Fees & Expenses for Property Purchase & Cyprus Permanent Residency

Minimum investment **From €300,000**

Value Added Tax (VAT) **5% to 19%**

Depending on property size and type

First-time buyers in Cyprus may qualify for a reduced VAT rate of 5% on the first 130m² of residential space instead of the standard 19%. The 14% difference can be reclaimed as a tax rebate.

The amount depends on the infrastructure within the development, the number of residential units, the property's energy efficiency rating, and its location.

Permanent Residency Acquisition: Step by Step



Consultation & Property Selection

1

Signing an agreement for **legal support with Astons** and paying **50% of the professional service fee**.

2

Selecting a property, **signing a preliminary sales agreement**, and making a **deposit payment**.

The property purchase must be completed before submitting the PR application. At this stage, the investor must also pay VAT (a tax refund can be obtained later).

3

Property Registration. The **sales contract is registered with the Land Registry**, carried out under a power of attorney by the company's legal team.

4

Obtaining Council of Ministers approval is mandatory for all non-EU foreign buyers before acquiring property in Cyprus.

5

Full payment for the property and transfer of ownership rights.

6

Submitting the PR application to the Department of Civil Registry and Migration.

7

Receiving approval and issuance of the Immigration Certificate.

8

Payment of the remaining 50% of the professional service fee.

9

Providing biometric data and obtaining a PR card.

10

Issuance of Residency Cards.

Within one year of receiving the Immigration Certificate, the applicant and their family (if included in the application) must submit biometric data to obtain residency cards.
